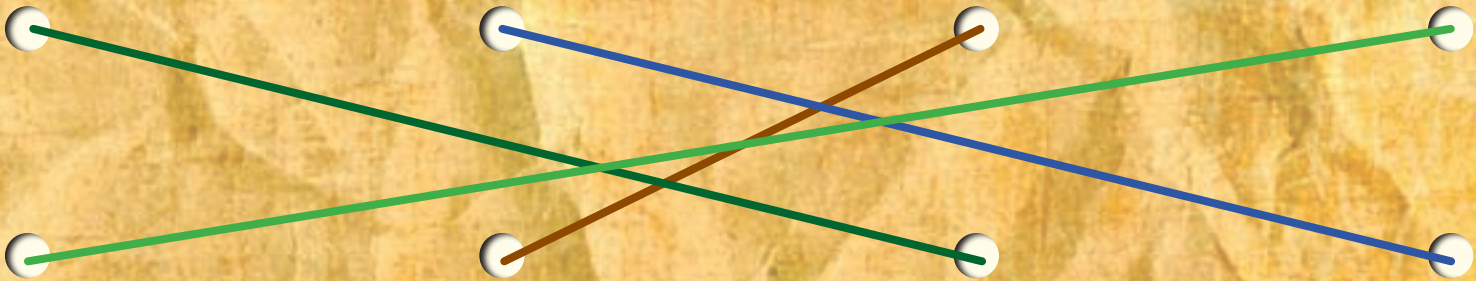

From the earliest recorded settlers to the modern town we see today, Bedok has changed dramatically from the period before the World War II till today. Bedok Heritage Corner features the lives and experiences of residents living in the Bedok area. The trail, on the other hand, seeks to capture the historical and social forces that have shaped the geography and development of the area. Social media will also be used to enhance participants' experiences on the trail.

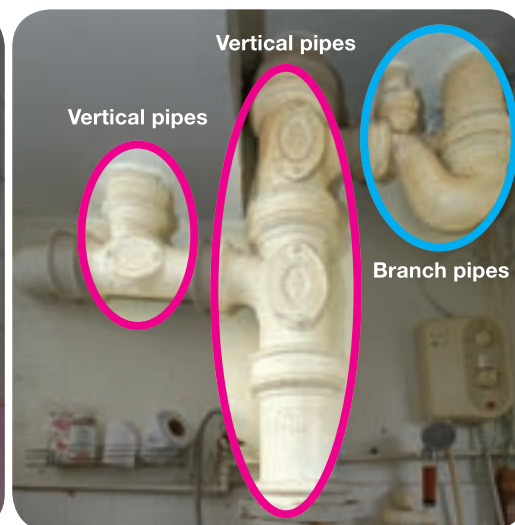
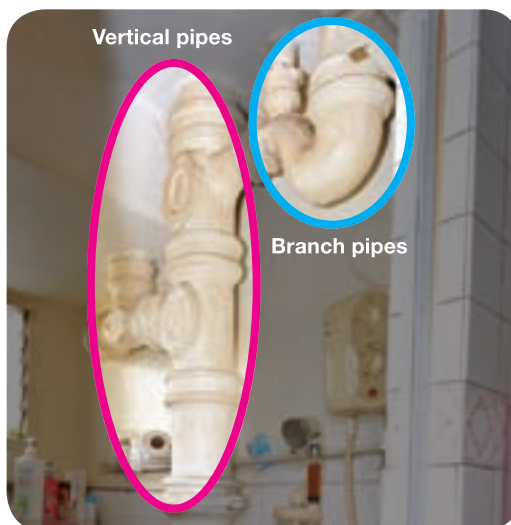
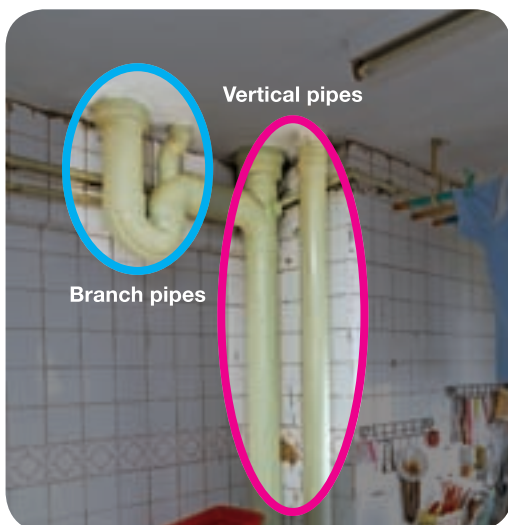
FACING LEAKING, CHOKED OR BURST PIPES?

If the pipes at home are giving you problems, here is a guide on who to seek help from when your pipes leak, choke or burst.

There are vertical and branch pipes. For vertical pipes, you may contact the Town Council at 1800 444 9549 (24 hours). In cases which urgently require our immediate attention, we will deploy our contractors accordingly.

If the branch pipes connecting to the vertical pipes (as shown) have problems, you will have to engage your own contractor to fix it as this is under the owner's responsibility.

You may also consider to engage our TC term contractor, Nam Plumbing Engineering Pte Ltd at 9666 7057 to fix the pipes. Upon completion, the contractor will issue an official receipt to the resident for the work done.

Assuring Our Pioneers of Affordable Healthcare



In East Coast, 120 Pioneer Generation (PG) ambassadors have helped about 11,000 pioneers to understand the benefits of Pioneer Generation package and MediShield Life. PG ambassadors are selected from a wide spectrum of different races to match the corresponding pioneer profiles. To reach out to them, ambassadors conduct house visits. The main objective is to connect with this generation who has contributed to nation-building, and most importantly, to assure them that they have access to affordable healthcare.

At the back end, ambassadors went through intensive training in both PG package and MediShield Life. Over the past few days, 150 more volunteers were recruited, based on selection criteria such as passion to serve the community, and time commitment. ONE COMMUNITY WALK 2015



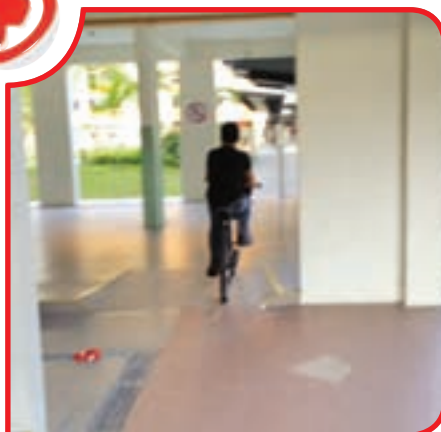

EDUCATION MERIT AWARD CEREMONY



Singapore is well known as a meritocratic society where equal opportunities are provided, regardless of race, language or religion. Held on 17 October 2015, two categories of awards were presented at Changi Simei CC, namely CDC/CCC ITE, Polytechnic and University Education Merit Awards, and CDC/CCC Education Merit Award. Member of Parliament, Ms Jessica Tan launched the ceremony. There was a total of 205 award recipients for the former category, and 398 for the latter. The CDC/CCC Education Merit Award recognises students who have done well academically, but are ineligible for the Edusave Merit Bursary (EMB) award due to their household income exceeding the income criterion set under the MOE's EMB. The value of this award is \$80 for Primary School, and \$100 for Secondary School, Pre-U, ITE respectively.

IN A HASTE TO FIGHT THE HAZE – DISTRIBUTION OF WECARE PACKS



Due to the worsening haze condition, People's Association embarked on a national exercise for the distribution of WeCare Packs. Each Division had 300 WeCare Packs for distribution to the needy and vulnerable residents staying in the constituency.
