

There will be increased accessibility to food and transport, made possible by an enhanced Pedestrian Mall. Elderly-friendly features such as gentle ramps and visually enhanced floors ensure a hassle-free and enjoyable shopping experience for senior citizens as well.

To commemorate the nation's 50th birthday, the National Parks Board (NParks), together with People's Association and the community, planted over 5,000 trees at more than 50 sites islandwide from 1 August to end December at parks, park connectors and nature ways.

Residents enthusiastically wrote well wishes on cards and pinned them on the trees. 

Overall, East Coast-Fengshan Town Council fared well in the recent Town Council Management Report (TCMR). It was given the green banding in four out of five areas. However, there is still room for improvement in the area of estate maintenance.

TCMR Colour Banding: Green Amber Red

The top observation under 'Estate Maintenance' in the TCMR was obstruction along corridors. This is dangerous as movement is hampered in cases of emergency.

As residents of our Town, please be considerate and keep your corridor free of obstruction. There should be a clear passageway of 1.2 m between the items (if any are placed) and the wall of the corridors.


