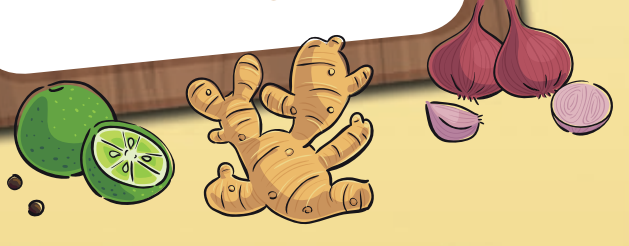

BEDOK TOWN SQUARE OPENING

The rejuvenated Bedok Town Centre included the upgrading of the existing Pedestrian Mall. It also connects to the Heritage Corner at the new town plaza where residents can learn about the rich history of Bedok town.

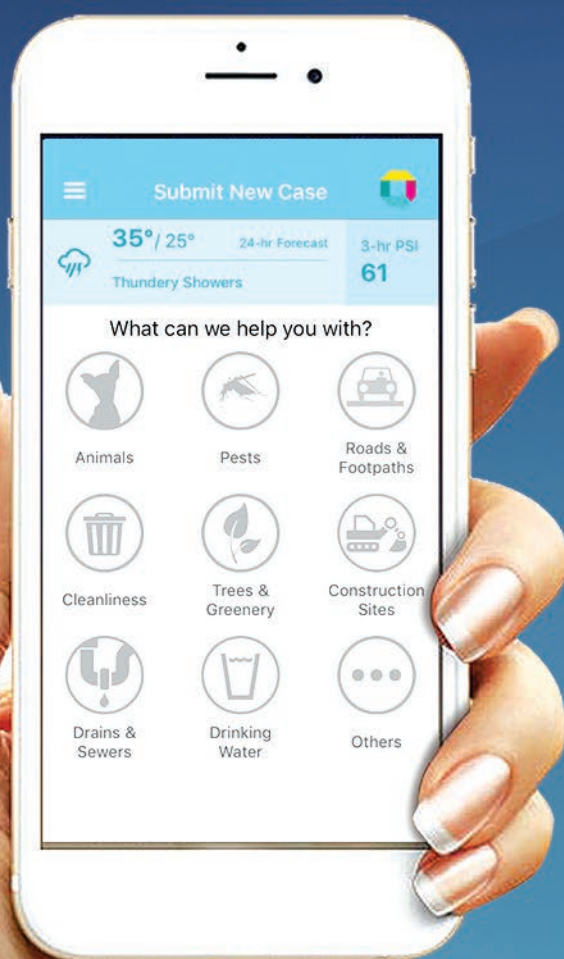
