




KEEP COMMON AREA CLEAN





I Was Retrenched Twice

It's never easy being retrenched. Mr Chu Seng Chou went through it not once but twice and each time it was as if his world was snatched away from him. His experience strengthened his resolve when he made career switches at later points in his career journey so that he stayed relevant in our fast-changing employment landscape.

I was retrenched after the Asian Financial Crisis in 1997 and the second time was during the economic recession in 2007. Both times, I was a QC Technician and the companies I worked with ceased their operations in Singapore. This was within a space of over five years between my previous job and my last job as a QC Technician.

That was when I made up my mind to forge my own career path so that I will not be retrenched for the third time. I realised that while I had a keen interest in computers, I also enjoyed meeting people. I decided to explore the Retail industry. In September 2009, I took up a course in WSQ Communication and Relationship Management - Operations, and a year later, the WSQ Certified Service Professional at the Singapore Institute of Retail Studies.

Even after sending out numerous applications for a suitable retail position, I still wasn't getting many interviews. Looking for answers, I went online and was excited to find out about Workforce Singapore's Careers Connect. That was how I met my Career Coach, Mr Wilson Ng, in 2011.

Benefits of Career Coaching

One of the first things that Wilson did was to assist me in reformatting my resume. Never did I expect this simple move would help change the course of my career.

First, he taught me to bring focus to my career objectives and made sure it highlighted my passionate interest in interacting with people. That helped to draw the immediate attention of potential employers when they viewed my personal details. Most importantly, he highlighted my 19 years of working experience in the retail, manufacturing, engineering and shipping industries. This made it easier for hiring managers to recognise my working experience without having to go through my employment details. The edits allowed me to summarise my strengths within the first page of the resume.

After reformatting my resume, I experienced a 75% increase in interview call-backs. The same resume that I had been using all these years was edited in a way that my strengths, personality and transferable skills stood out and highlighted why I was suited for the retail positions. Within a month, I was employed as a Retail Associate.

Both times, I was a QC Technician and the companies I worked with ceased their operations in Singapore. Second Career Switch

After working in the Retail industry for almost five years, I decided to make a second career switch to the Information Technology (IT) services field. I never stopped learning and acquiring new skills. To arm myself with the relevant skills, I enrolled in the NICF Advanced Certificate in IT Services (Infrastructure Support).

Today, at age 46, even though I have moved on to a new job as a Desktop Support Engineer, I still keep in constant contact with Wilson, to share the progress in my career, and he is just a phone call away if I need any career advice."

Mr Chu Seng Chou has benefited from Careers Connect's career matching services. He worked in the retail industry for almost five years before making a career switch to the IT services field.



2018 S&CC Rebates for HDB Residents

As announced in the 2018 Budget, eligible HDB households will receive S&CC Rebate to offset between 1.5 to 3.5 months of S&CC. The S&CC Rebate will cost \$126 million and benefit about 900,000 eligible HDB households. If you are paying for your S&CC through GIRO, no action is required on your part. The Town Council arrange with your bank on the amount of S&CC that your household will have to pay to the Town Council, after taking the S&CC rebates into account.
