Thank you to the residents who participated in our e-waste recycling campaign! During a collection drive held on 9 and 10 November 2019, a whopping 1,612kg of e-waste was collected. An award ceremony was held on 30 November to recognise the top three residents' associations that had collected the most amount of e-waste. Member of Parliament Ms Cheryl Chan graced the event and presented the awards to the winning teams.

E-waste recycling involves repurposing certain parts of electrical or electronic devices to reduce the amount of waste that fills our landfills. It also protects our health and physical environment by ensuring harmful substances in electrical/electronic items are handled properly in the right hands. Eradicating e-waste is part of the national Towards Zero Waste movement.

The Town Council is happy to initiate this movement across the five divisions. The National Environment Agency and South East Community Development Council collaborated with us to make this collection drive possible.

MY HOME AND MY HEART IN FENGSHAN

Ms Celine has been a Fengshan resident for more than 30 years. Initially, she stayed at Block 119 Bedok North Road with her family, but moved to Block 83 after giving birth to her daughter. She currently stays near Block 180.

How was Fengshan like when you moved here?

The blocks have pretty much stayed the same over the years. 85 Market was already here when we shifted in, and it's my mom's favourite place. She loves to do marketing there. The hawker centre opens from morning till night, which is very convenient.

Was there any difference between the estate now and the estate then?

The facilities got better throughout the years, especially in the past 5-10 years. As my mom's mobility is limited, all the sheltered linkways and barrier-free access have helped her move more freely and conveniently. There are also ramps along the roads which help to slow down vehicles. This helps ensure her safety, especially since she cannot walk fast. My daughter enjoys going to the playgrounds around the estate too. Our family really appreciates all these changes that have benefitted us.

Will there be any possibility that you move out of this estate in the future?

Not at all! My mom and most of my siblings stay nearby. We will gather thrice weekly to enjoy meals prepared by my mother since it is so convenient to do so. This is a place we grew up in, and we have not considered moving out of this estate.

SHE BUILDS THE SIMEI SPIRIT

Mdm Lim "Moon" has been living in Simei since 1987!

How was Simei like when you moved here? And now?

When we moved here, there were no trains and buses. Now that there is an MRT, many buses, and even a mall, it's very convenient.

Which community events have you joined, and what keeps you going?

I have joined different activities since I shifted here. I love to practise Tai Chi and I have been practising with other residents for many years. I also help the senior care community, which I enjoy. I feel very happy seeing the seniors enjoy themselves. Everyone loves to go on outings together and their smiles are what keep me going. We used to organise trips to the Zoo, Sentosa, Jurong Bird Park etc. Nowadays, we go shopping for Chinese New Year clothes and food!

Is organising these trips challenging?

Sometimes, the elderly residents do not adhere to the event timings and are uncontactable. Their absence makes me worried for their safety as they usually live alone and would have no one to help them in an emergency.

How have the community activities affected your personal lifestyle?

My family says I spend too much time participating in community activities, but as these activities bring me so much joy, I will have to find the balance. I am currently focusing on improving the health of myself and my family.

What do you like about the estates?

The estates are pretty convenient to travel around and are very clean. I have also made lots of friends here and we even go travelling together. Simei is a great place!

What new facilities would you like to see?

It would be great if there is a wet market here. I am also waiting for the laundry pipe socket holders to be upgraded to a rack. As residents get older, it is harder for us to hold the poles and carry them in and out.

EVERYDAY HEROES

IN OUR NEIGHBOURHOOD

Our everyday heroes ensure patients' well-being at the bedside, assist in surgeries and guide patients on healthy living, amongst other amazing things they do every day! But have you ever wondered what nurses do in the community? It's a different ball game altogether!

Changi General Hospital (CGH) Advanced Practice Nurse Gan Peiying takes her work into the heartlands every day. Here's her story.

"The Community Nursing Department at CGH provides its services via various programmes, one of them being the Community Nurse Posts (CNP) located in senior activity centres, faith-based organisations and community centres. This way, the team hopes to provide better access to good healthcare and encourage more seniors to take charge of their health. We also collaborate with community partners to help seniors who need more support.

A typical session at the CNP begins with a consultation. Sometimes, it can last up to an hour each! We screen for common health issues and educate the elderly on managing their conditions.

If they are well, we teach them ways to maintain their health and age gracefully.

If required, we visit the seniors who are unable to come to us. These cases are referred to us by our community partners.

Nurses have to be very independent in the community and we have to think on our feet. During a case discussion, one of my colleagues shared that she needed to dress a patient's wound but there wasn't any available surface that could be used. She then had a stroke of genius – she wiped down the luggage she was using to carry medical supplies and used it as an alternative to a table top and got the job done.

My name is Gan Peiying and I go places with my job. I choose to be a nurse."



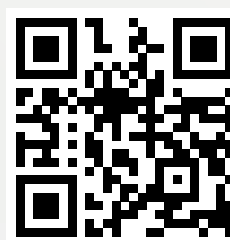

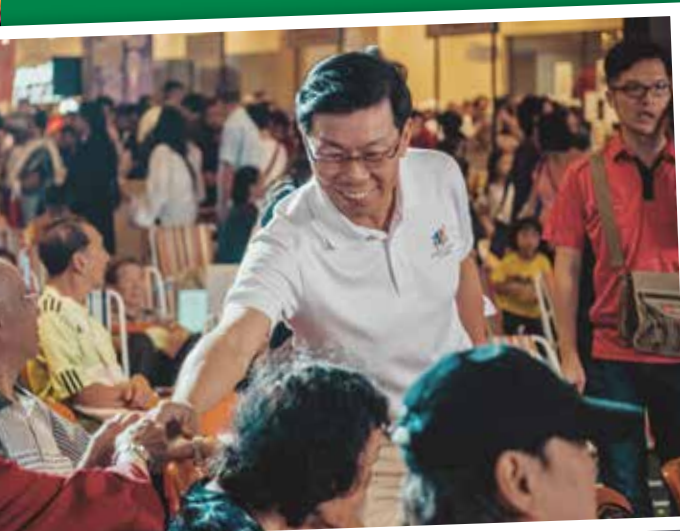

LIFT ENHANCEMENT PROGRAMME (LEP)

Please be informed that we have appointed Fujitec Singapore Corpn Ltd to carry out enhancement works to the lift(s).

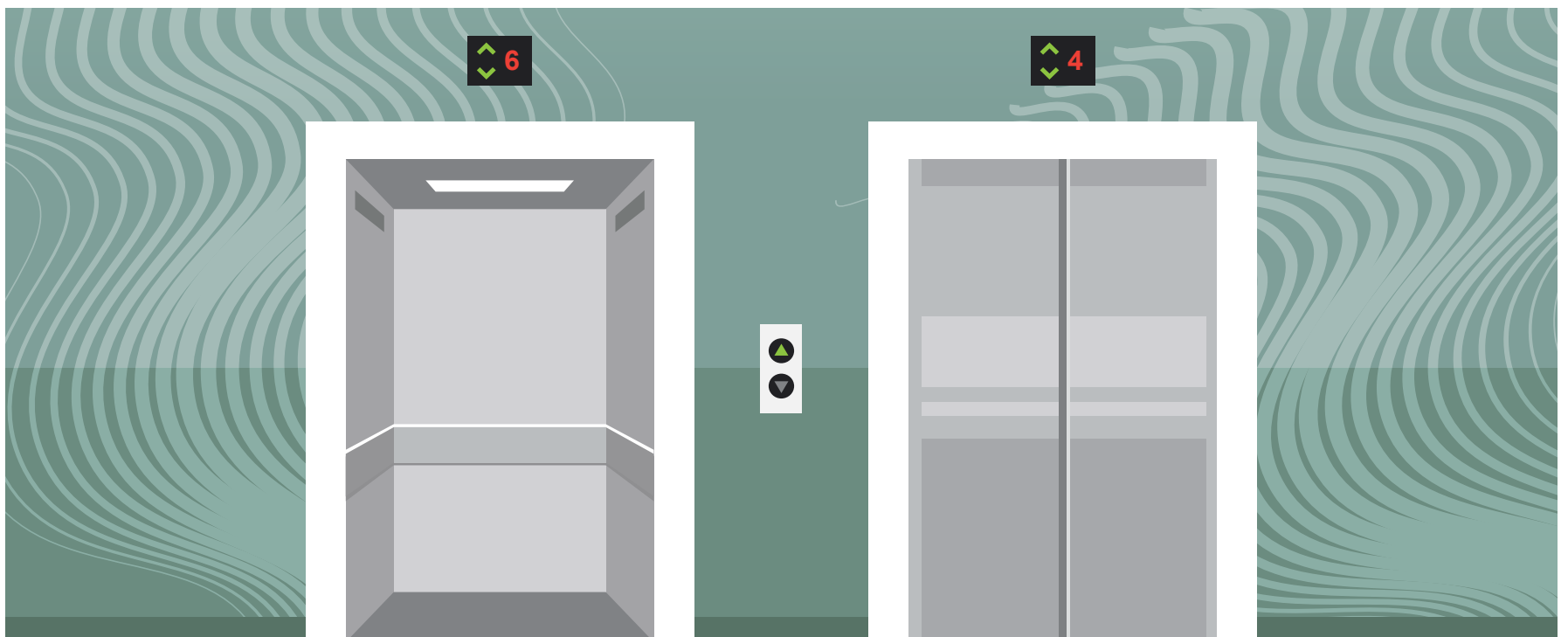
As the lifts were installed by HDB some time back, there is a need to enhance/upgrade the safety features to comply with the latest Building and Construction Authority (BCA) requirements. Hence, we require the lifts to be shut down to facilitate these works.

The 6 safety features that will be carried out under the Lift Enhancement Programme (LEP) include:

1. ACOP – Ascending Car Overspeed Protection
2. UCMP – Unintentional Car Movement Protection
3. Slacken Governor Rope Electrical Safety Device
4. Car Apron
5. Light Curtains as a Door Protective Device
6. Electrical Safety Interlocking for Multi-panel Door

During the work progress, some noise will be generated. We will take precautions to minimise the noise and inconvenience caused to residents.

LEP will be fully funded by the HDB and Town Council.

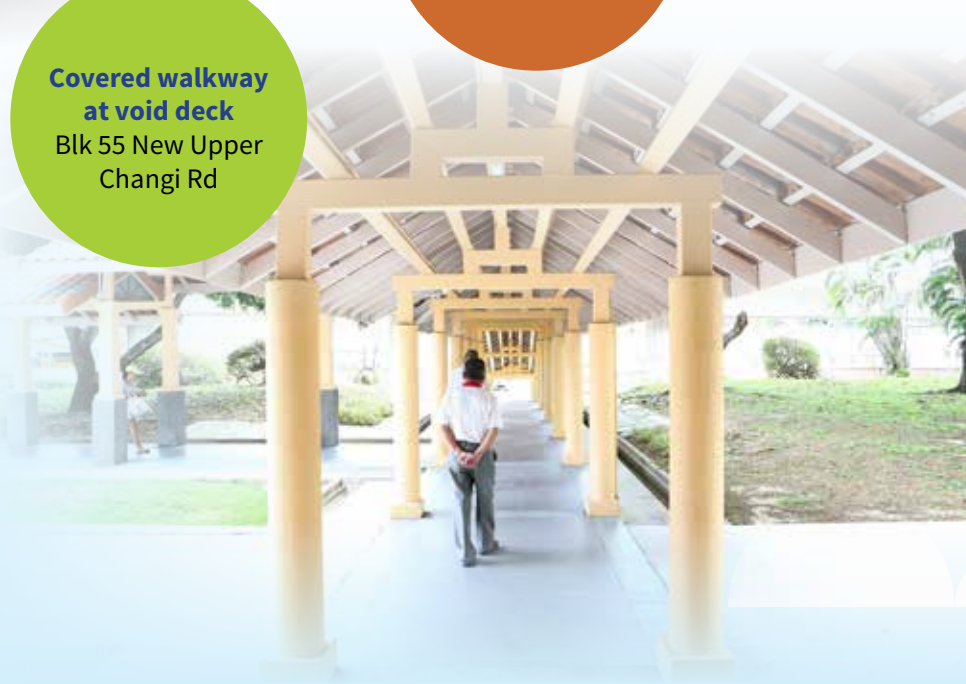
