Feedback

Giving constructive and feasible feedback to the Council, so that the Town Council (TC) can improve the standard of our living environment.



Quarterly Night Inspection

RC/RN members carry out night inspections with the TC staff to identify defects in their estates.

RC/RN take care of their own Community Gardens such as trimming of water shoots, housekeeping and watering of plants.



Block Cleaning

Residents carry out monthly block cleaning to improve the standard of cleanliness of their estates. This helps to inculcate residents with good social behavior.

OUR HABITS MATTER

The 2019 Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) spread has got many of us wondering how to best protect ourselves and our loved ones. All of us play a critical part in halting the spread of the virus. Let's practise good personal hygiene, adhere to travel regulations, and stay up-to-date with news regarding the COVID-19 spread.

Personal hygiene tips to contain spread of viruses:



Wash your hands regularly using soap and water, and for at least 20 seconds - the time it takes to sing "Happy Birthday" twice!



If you are unwell, wear a mask and see a doctor immediately.

Visit www.flugowhere. gov.sg/ to obtain the list of Public Health **Preparedness Clinics** (PHPCs) that you can visit in our town.



Avoid crowded places and events. If it is unavoidable, be seated at least 1 metre apart from others, and reduce contact with others (e.g. avoid shaking hands).

Travel regulations during this period:

Singaporeans are advised to defer all travel to Hubei province and non-essential travel to mainland China, Iran, Japan and the Republic of Korea, Italy, France, **Spain and Germany.**

If you have travelled abroad, monitor your health closely for two weeks upon returning to Singapore. Seek medical attention promptly if you feel unwell.

If you develop a fever or respiratory problems (e.g. cough, shortness of breath), call your clinic ahead of time to schedule your appointment.

When seeking medical attention, wear a mask and inform the doctor of your travel history.

Given the evolving situation and ongoing investigations in Asia and Europe, Singaporeans who need to travel to the affected areas are advised to regularly check MOH's website for updates.

East Coast-Fengshan resident Mr Johnny Chia has been a driver for ridehailing app Grab since 2016. When the GrabCare programme was launched early this year, Mr Chia signed up with the intention to show his support for healthcare workers. He shares about his reasons for taking a step many would not.

"I first heard about this service from the Grab app. I wanted to participate because healthcare staff are working hard on the frontlines at this critical period and they deserve the transport services.

Initially I was hesitant to join as I have three young kids, but when I think back to the times my sons visited the hospital in the past, I recall healthcare staff always being patient and nice. I felt that we should support them in these circumstances. After all, the situation is under control currently, and we must thank them for their efforts.

My family supported my decision to join GrabCare. My group of driver friends signed up for it as well. There was once my neighbours avoided taking the same lift as me as they know that I am a Grab driver but I understand how they feel. I did not sleep with my family in the initial stages of GrabCare. Instead, I would sleep in the living room. To protect myself, I wear a mask in the car. I air the car and wipe the seats after every trip too.

I am thankful for the healthcare workers at our frontlines and appreciate all their hard work and effort."

PUTTING OUR BEST FOOT FORWARD TO BATTLE COVID-19

Caring for residents' health and well-being through best estate management practices has always been our top priority. As the current COVID-19 outbreak period calls for extra care and precaution, we have stepped up and introduced measures to keep community spread risk minimal. These include:



Stepping up cleaning works at common areas that have high human traffic or many physical touchpoints.

Railings, playground equipment and lift buttons are cleaned with disinfectant daily. The conservancy team is also protected as they wear gloves, and sanitise their hands after finishing their cleaning works.

A RENEWED NEIGHBOURHOOD REJUVENATES MINDS





The Fengshan Breakfast and Neighbourhood Renewal Programme (NRP) Public Consultation and Exhibition, held at Block 94D Bedok North Avenue 4 from 15 to 16 February 2020, showcased proposed estate improvements such as new covered linkways, dropoff porches, barrier-free ramps and new precinct markers. These improvements span from Blocks 94A (multi-storey carpark) and 94B to 94E Bedok North Avenue 4.

"The main concepts are to promote inter-connectivity between blocks and amenities through linkages, and also to encourage healthier living. By building a community garden, we hope to get more residents to share the joy of gardening as well as eat more healthily," Mr Chua Seow Ann, the architect for this NRP, explained.

Mr Joseph Loo, 60, was pleased that his days of carrying an umbrella are waning due to the proliferation of covered linkways in the near future.

BUDGET 2020: A HELPING HAND FOR ALL SINGAPOREANS

The Budget 2020 Care & Support Package is an initiative that will benefit all Singaporeans, and was introduced to ease household and living costs. Read on to find out the benefits that are in store for you!



For individual Singaporeans

- Up to \$300 for Singaporeans aged 21 and above
- Additional \$100 for each Singaporean parent with at least one Singaporean child aged 20 and below in 2020
- \$100 PAssion Card top up for Singaporeans aged 50 and above in 2020
- Additional 20% workfare payments for work done in 2019, with a minimum payment of \$100
- Cash payout of \$700 to \$1,600 over 5 years for adult Singaporeans to offset GST expenses
- \$500 SkillsFuture Credit top-up for Singaporeans aged 25 and above
- Additional \$500 SkillsFuture Credit top-up for Singaporeans aged 40-60



For households living in HDB flats

- \$100/year in grocery vouchers in 2020 and 2021 for Singaporeans aged 21 and above living in 1- or 2- room flats
- Double the regular U-Save voucher for eligible households
- Larger households get 2.5 times the regular U-Save amount in 2020
- GST offsets worth 5-10 years for most Singaporean households
- S&CC rebates amounting to 1.5-3.5 months for eligible households

For students receiving financial assistance from MOE

- Higher pre-university bursary quantum of \$1000
- Increased transport subsidies


